In 2022, St Stephen's School continued to demonstrate why it is a leading West Australian Private School, with strong student results across all learning pathways.

- The cross-campus median ATAR was 86.5 with the State's median ATAR being 83.45
- More than 97% of students who applied were offered their first course preference at University
- Class of 2022 VET students achieved 64 Certificate III or IV qualifications, along with 60 Certificate II awards in a range of learning areas




